PRN position offered as fill in nursing staff to relieve core staff during call outs, shortages, etc. Daily tasks included providing medications as ordered, management of wound care orders in coordination with wound care nurse, coordination of care and lunch breaks with other nursing staff and delegation of tasks to LPNs and CNAs for daily patient care in the long-term setting of Arizona's Veterans.

- Daily reassessments, medication administration, focused assessments such as neurological, skin, or endocrine changes. Updating the treatment plan according to changes of condition and daily/weekly interdisciplinary treatment team meetings.
- Coordinated care with other units for LPN assistance such as notifying provider, assisting other staff during a critical event such as a patient fall, or assisting staff if a patient was sent out to a local hospital during emergencies.
- Training and education provided to staff as needed such as changes in policies and protocols as well as coordinating team management with Director and Assistant Director of Nursing with other supervising staff.
- Coordination of medical management but also specialized in psychiatric care with psychiatric providers for common changes of condition or behavioral issues such as PTSD, Trauma, Delerium, Aggression, and Dementia care.



Hospice RN Case Manager - East Valley

Manage daily, weekly, and monthly tasks of Hospice Care relating to various disease processes, prognostics for Medicare compliance and assisting with educating and guiding patients and families through the details of what Hospice Care is. Providing direct patient care, education, and use of durable medical equipment. Assisted in medication management, administration, placing direct medical orders and coordinated refills for patients regularly and as needed for change in condition or decline in status.

- Worked closely with the Interdisciplinary Team of Professionals that included Physicians, Case Managers, Social Workers, Spiritual Care, Music Therapy as well as administration and management.
- Coordinated Admissions, management of symptoms, patient deaths and discharges; all depending on prognosis.
- Assist patients and family members with a holistic approach to death with dignity, including post-mortem follow up from a psycho-social perspective for 1 year after patients expired.
- Coordinate with various facilities, group homes, and retirement centers with coordination of patient care including
 educating facility staff on plan of care or treatment orders, medication administration and management, close
 monitoring of narcotic medications such as liquid morphine, and assisting and supporting facility staff of emotional
 support of the patients they cared for as they progressed toward death and dying.

Manage the daily admissions of patients for inpatient acute psychiatric care. Responsible for 11 - 14 patients at any given time, including conducting safety checks and administering medications and treatment plans prescribed by the medical and psychiatric providers/practitioners. Maintain regular communication with parents, case managers, social workers, and other providers. Coordinate with treatment team for behavioral and medication stabilization. Responsible for charting, assessments, and maintaining electronic health record.

- Effectively assisted patients with direct detoxification from alcohol and substance abuse, as well as patients for suicidal precautions, self-harm or cutting behaviors, aggression, assault, sexual abuse, and trauma.
- Maintain safety of all patients and staff members daily throughout management of observations, assessing patient's
 daily for changes in suicidal ideation, homicidal ideation, auditory or visual hallucinations as well as monitored units
 daily for changes in environment, contraband, or missing or damaged items.
- Utilized advanced verbal de-escalation techniques such as redirection, acknowledgement, empathy and rephrasing in order to prevent further episodes of aggression or hostility that patients would present towards themselves, peers or other staff members.
